"The Gateway to the Klondike," **Skagway** is preserved as a National Historic Park and features one of the oldest narrow-gauge railroads in existence.

August 2 B, L, D Hubbard Glacier
Stretching over 90 miles long and covering over 1,350 square miles in area, Hubbard Glacier is the largest tidewater glacier in North America. It is also one of the most impressive, a 300-foot wall of ice rising sheer and jagged from the ocean. You may hear the rumble and see the monumental splash as the glacier severs into great ice chunks, known as "calves."

August 3 B, L Anchorage, AK
Disembark this morning in Seward, then transfer to **Anchorage**, where the average temperature is 65 degrees. Have lunch in a warm atmosphere of Alaskan hospitality in a replica of an old mill house and dine on fresh seafood and local specialties. In the afternoon, visit the Alaska Native Heritage Center and see the world-renowned complex dedicated to preserving the legacy of indigenous tribes in this region.

August 4 Home
Transfer to the Anchorage airport for your flight home, with a new appreciation for the grand, natural beauty of Alaska.
